Join us for a Family Ramble and Nature StoryWalk© *Owl Moon*

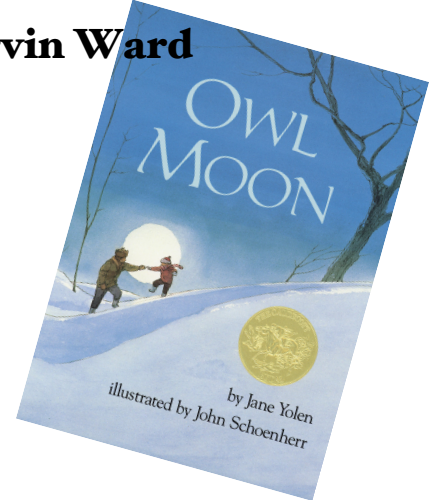
