Current PreK-K

- The current PreK-K mixed cohort with Ms. Birtwell has been very successful and enjoyable

- Option 2-Jackie can present to the SES school committee an option to approve five spots for school choice first graders

Marketing

- Growth in school choice and charter schools in MA makes future enrollment at SES more unpredictable

Playground

- Jess is leading a playground grant initiative that recently applied for a Community Preservation Council (\$5,000 to build a 1/8 mile track in the back field and \$25,000 to make our PreK-K playground handicap accessible and accessible to both adults and their children)
- It will cost an additional \$150,000 to fix the big playground

Lunch
