All students must follow the established guidelines as stated in the Acceptable Use Policy - (IJNDB) in order to maintain access privileges to school resources. The following is a summary of the four guiding principles of the Acceptable Use Policy:

Respect	Exercise proper online etiquette using appropriate language and graphics

	Understand that illegal activity and cyberbullying is prohibited
Privacy	Keep passwords private and only use your assigned computer account
	Understand that SES has the right to review all files and activity
	<ul> <li>Know that content filtering blocks access to certain sites and actions to avoid this protection is prohibited</li> </ul>
Sharing	Use electronic communications to promote educational excellence and reflect intellectual activities
	Follow the general communications guidelines listed in the Acceptable Use Policy
Safety	Never share private information about yourself and others
	Only access teacher-approved resources and websites
	Report any inappropriate communications, material or behavior to a trusted adult

Students will be given access to the internet and other electronic resources only if a caregiver provides written consent. Access to all electronic resources will remain in force for the duration of the student's enrollment unless revoked due to violations of the Acceptable Use Policy.
